WHERE DO WE HUNT?

We hunt in an area that is located at 40 min drive from the airport of Mérida, in the South East of Mexico. We operate in a UMA of 25,000 hectares which contains lowland forest, agricultural areas and waterholes, which guarantees us a good population of wildlife.


It is necessary to arrive on Sunday, and your hunt begins on Monday and ends on Thursday, and on Friday you will move to the Mérida airport.













THE CAMP:

The Lodge is inside the UMA, it has rooms with air conditioning, full bathroom with shower, satellite TV, palapa, rest area, dining room, Internet.

FOOD:

The food is International type and include American cuts, chicken, fish, shrimp, salads and wild turkey.

All drinks are included and consist of bottled water and soft drinks.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

In March and April it is the dry season and it is very hot.

The average temperature is 28°C at night and can reach 42°C during the day.

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT:

- Camouflage clothing including mask
- Gloves
- Head mosquito net
- Field boots
- T-shirts
- Shorts
- Tennis
- Multi tool knife
- Flashlight
- Mosquito repellent
- Sunscreen
- Bathroom items























For national hunters, a valid hunting credential is required.

If you wish to bring your weapons, it will be necessary to carry the current

SEDENA for the state of Yucatán.

It is recommended to bring a 12-gauge shotgun and magnum cartridges with #2 ammunition.


For your convenience, we have 12 gauge semi-automatic and cartridge shotguns available.

TERMS AND PAYMENT METHODS:

- All prices are in American dollars
- A \$2,000 usd partial deposit is required to reserve dates for the Turkey hunt
- Hunting deposits may be moved to next year (if the client wishes) according to price changes, if 90 days or more notice is given
- Advance payments are not refundable under any circumstances
- The advance payment can be transferred to the account of a new hunter only with more than 90 days notice
- Hunt prices will be subject to change until the full 50% deposit of the hunt is received
- The hunt must be paid in full at least 60 days before the start date of your hunt
- The probability of success for Turkey hunting is around 95%
- The company is not responsible for sudden weather changes, which could cause the partial or total suspension of the hunt
- It is offered that the hunt takes place in an area with a good population
- .12 caliber shotguns and #4 Magnum cartridges or #2 Magnum ammunition are recommended for this hunt
- Advance payments are non-refundable, only substitute hunters are accepted
- Groups are maximum of 5 hunters

Note: Any injured animal is considered a killed animal Non-hunters: \$300 daily
